## About Sazolie College of Teacher Education

Sazolie College of Teacher Education is an educational institution run and established under the aegis of **Rüchüniü Academy of Education**, on 21<sup>st</sup> September 2010.It is recognized by National Council of Teachers Education (NCTE) Eastern Region, Bhubaneswar, and provisionally affiliated to Nagaland University.

# Location

Sazolie College of Teacher Education (SCTE), is located in a spacious campus at Jotsoma village of Kohima district, Nagaland. The college is situated on the prominent slopes of Mount Puliebadze, which is a part of the lofty Barail Range. Distanced about 5km away from Kohima, it adjoins Kohima Science College on its northern side, overlooking it. On the eastern side, it has a panoramic view of Kohima and the surrounding areas. On the southern side, it is surrounded by the magnificent and majestic Puliebadze mountain range and on the west, by the lower range of beautiful undulating mountains. The evergreen, forested mountain ranges provide not only a protective wall but also a spectacular natural beauty. Situated in the midst of such a surrounding, the campus has a secluded, serene and peaceful atmosphere, conducive to learning and growth that is wholesome.

## **Facilities:**

### Library

The College library has been computerized providing an easy access for the students to get information on e-materials. The library provides an array of books, magazines, periodical journals and newspapers, both local, National and international. At present, the library has about 5325 volumes covering various fields of study.

### Accommodation

There are two hostels- "Spring" for the girls and "Rock" for the Boys, inspired from the natural characteristics of the location, and the positivity it connotes. The hostel can accommodate around 150 Students in total, of which one houses the dining halls that caters to various palates.

In general, the facility such as classrooms, library, and hostels are arguably one of the best in Kohima.

### **Staff Quarters**

Most of the staffs are housed on campus in permanent quarters, thereby enabling the college to function more efficiently.

#### Games & Sports

So far, the staff and students enjoy the facilities for basketball, volleyball, lawn tennis, table tennis and badminton. The present land is adequate to establish more facilities for games and sports as well. The multipurpose hall that is also worth mentioning facilitates to some of these activities besides formal programs.

#### **Other facilities**

Students and staff can avail the college bus service that operates everyday to and fro Kohima.

The college has its own water source from a perennial stream nearby and its supply is abundant throughout the year.

## Admission Procedure:

- 1) Date and place(s) of issuing and submission of application from will be published in the newspaper in the month of May.
- 2) Candidates securing a minimum of 50% for General and 45% of SC/ST at the Graduation or Post Graduation level only may apply.
- 3) There is no upper age limit.
- 4) Attested Photostat copies of Admit Cards, Mark Sheets, Provisional Certificate and Original Certificate of the Board/ University (from HSLC/HSSLC till the last degree completed) are to be submitted together with the application form.
- 5) Eligibility Certificate for B.Ed. Course from Nagaland University should be submitted at the time of admission.
- 6) Students coming from Universities other than Nagaland University are to submit their **Migration Certificate** at the time of admission.
- 7) All the original documents to be produced during the time of interview.
- 8) Selection process will be done through written test and personal interview.
- 9) Date of interview, admissions and other relevant information will be displayed on the College Notice Board.
- 10) Preference will be given to the eligible candidate from Nagaland.
- 11) Admission once taken, fee will not be refundable.

#### **Choosing of optional subjects**

Those students who are in the Arts stream will be offered

- a) English
- b) Social Science

and those who are in the Science stream can take the following subjects:

- a) Teaching of Mathematics
- b) Teaching of Science

\*A minimum of 85% attendance is mandatory in order to appear for the University Examination.
